KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Conforming to general health, safety and welfare in the workplace
- Set out and build brickwork, including complex arches and surrounding brickwork, curved on plan, concave and convex brickwork and battered brickwork.
- Mixing mortar by hand or with a mechanical mixer
- Laying the bricks on top of each other and applying the mortar with a trowel
- Shape and trim bricks/blocks using hammers, chisels and power tools. Use of laser levels, spirit levels, optical levels and string lines to check that courses are straight, horizontally and vertically, and laid to a gauge.
- Operating equipment on site in a safe manner

- Excellent time keeping skills with the ability to work in adverse weather conditions
- Desire to go to a training provider and learn additional theory and practical within this trade
- Maths and English grades at grade 2 (grade E+) or above or equivalent
- Practical skills including working with hands tools
- Able to work at heights as you will be working on top of secure scaffolding and towers
- Excellent communication skills, able to work in a team and on your own
- Flexible approach to working on different sites
- Passionate about construction
