BRICKLAYING KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Conforming to general health, safety, and welfare in the workplace
- Set out and build brickwork, including complex arches and surrounding brickwork, curved on plan, concave and convex brickwork and battered brickwork
- Mixing mortar by hand or with a mechanical mixer
- Laying the bricks on top of each other and applying the mortar with a trowel
- Shape and trim bricks/blocks using hammers, chisels, and power tools.
- Use of laser levels, spirit levels, optical levels, and string lines to check that courses are straight, horizontally, and vertically, and laid to a gauge
- Operating equipment on site in a safe manner

CARPENTRY KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Conforming to general health, safety and welfare in the workplace
- Using a range of hand and power tools
- Building studwork walls and staircases
- Hanging doors

- Pitching roofs
- Wood finishing (to doors, windows and windowsills)
- Fitting kitchens
- Measuring, marking out, cutting, finishing, positioning and securing
- Safely storing materials, without causing damage
- Installing floor joist coverings
- Fitting hinges
