WHAT TO EXPECT

Our trade apprenticeships will give you a thorough grounding in your chosen trade with an award-winning company. Lasting over three years, they combine paid, on-the-job training and work experience with college-based study that will leave you with nationally recognised industry qualifications.

You can choose between apprenticeships in Brickwork, Carpentry and Joinery, Plumbing and Electrical and Groundworks. We are always looking to expand our apprenticeship offering with other trade disciplines as required by our divisions and developments – if you are interested in a particular trade, please let us know.

You'll work with one of our trusted subcontractors on a Redrow housing development that's local to you. You'll also attend a nearby college that's contracted to the Construction Industry Training Board or JTL training, our preferred apprenticeship providers. Your study will vary, depending on your apprenticeship, but everyone will complete a Diploma specific to their discipline, and reach NVQ Level 2 and the opportunity to progress on to Level 3 for those who perform well.

OFFICE APPRENTICES

Redrow is a rapidly growing business, with award-winning products and big ambitions. With our commitment to developing the next generation's talent, it's a great place to launch your business career in the thriving construction sector.

WHAT TO EXPECT

With this apprenticeship, you'll provide vital business and administrative support to our thriving company. As well as gaining vital experience of the business world, you'll also be given a challenging role with real responsibilities of your own, where there'll be plenty of opportunity to use your initiative and impress those around you.

Initially, this will be a 2 year contract, which will give you plenty of time to attain your NVQ Level 2 in Business Administration. You'll complete this qualification at our offices, and you'll be visited on site by your NVQ Assessors. Perform well and you will have the opportunity to work towards your NVQ Level 3.

Depending on the department you are placed with, ranging from construction, sales or land to technical, customer service or administration, you will learn a variety of different skills and see a different side to housebuilding in the construction industry.

Impress us and at the end of the apprenticeship there could also be opportunities to join us in a permanent role.

TECHNICAL APPRENTICES

In this scheme, you'll join our highly-talented technical team. They're the ones who think about every single detail so that we create beautifully designed homes that have superb 'kerb appeal'. For each location, they create the architectural and engineering designs that will form the basis of the new development.

WHAT TO EXPECT

In this apprenticeship, you'll have the chance to learn about the whole housebuilding process, from the initial feasibility study on a piece of land to the delivery of final layouts to our sales team. Covering Architecture to Civil Engineering and everything in between, the programme is delivered over a two-year period, in partnership with Coleg Cambria. All our Technical apprentices complete a BTEC Level 3 Diploma in Construction and the Built Environment. You'll study for an NVQ Level 3 in either Architectural Design or Civil Engineering, on a block release basis.

For those who excel during the apprenticeship there'll also be opportunities to go on to study a fully funded degree and gain a full professional membership.

COMMERCIAL APPRENTICES

Every new home we build costs money. It's the job of our commercial team to make sure we're spending it wisely. Join them, and you'll learn how to deliver the best possible homes for the best possible price directly from the experts.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Based in one of our Divisional offices, our commercial apprentices have the chance to learn all about quantity surveying from some of the best in the industry. It's a two-year programme, delivered in partnership with the University College of Estate Management and the Royal Institute of Chartered Surveyors. You'll be based at Redrow offices, working towards your BTEC diploma and your Associate of the Royal Institute of Chartered Surveyors status. You will attend workshops along with other apprentices across industry, with coursework and online learning to complete and submit using the Virtual Learning Environment (VLE).

For those who make a real mark, there'll also be the opportunity to go on to study for your Higher National Certificate or degree and gain a full RICS membership – all fully funded by us. There really is no better way to start your career in the industry.
